**George Kiloh** is a member of the BDHS Committee, Chairman of the Society from 2016 to 2021 and editor of its annual Journal. He read history at Oxford and after a brief dalliance with politics and the law (his own words) went into university administration.

He has worked in four continents and his last substantive post was as academic registrar of the London School of Economics. Other jobs were at the beginning of the Open University in 1970 and as the first registrar of what became the Hong Kong Open University in 1989. He has lived in Sussex since 1990, but in Battle only since 2010. His main historical interests are in post-1815 Europe.

His 2015 publication 'The Brave Remembered', published by the Society, deals not only with those who died in the 1914-18 war but also with those who returned, trying to treat them as humans and not just names on stones. His latest book "Battle Characters", also a Society publication, commemorates more than 60 notable individuals through the years with connections to Battle and the neighbouring parishes.
